1. The purpose of studying the discipline :

to prepare a specialist - a dentist with developed social, personal, civic and patriotic qualities, with a high level of intellectual and moral development, possessing the competencies necessary to provide qualified medical care to the population, ready and able to continuously improve and integrate scientific knowledge in accordance with the requirements of the world community. The study of the discipline is aimed at acquiring by students the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for the formation of the specialty 31.05.03 Dentistry (specialty level) provided for by the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education 3++.

2. Objectives of the discipline:

- to form an understanding of the essence of law and its role in everyday and professional activities;
- ensure the assimilation of constitutional principles and provisions on the protection of citizens' health, as a guarantee of ensuring the rights and legitimate interests of citizens of the Russian Federation in the field of health care;
- to provide an idea of the system of civil, labor, criminal and administrative legal relations and their connection with future professional activities;
- to form a set of knowledge about the fundamentals of legal regulation of relations arising in the public health protection system;
- to form an understanding of the content of the legal status of medical workers and medical organizations, patients and the main constitutional and legal mechanisms for their provision in modern healthcare.

3. The place of the discipline in the structure of the OOP

The discipline "Jurisprudence, Medical Law" refers to the elective part of Block 1 "Disciplines (modules)" of the OOP VO in the specialty 31.05.03 Dentistry (specialist level). The discipline is focused on the formation of knowledge, skills and abilities in the field of law.

To study the discipline "Jurisprudence, Medical Law" a student must:

- know the basic concepts of social sciences and humanities,
- possess the skills of logical thinking, analysis, systematization, generalization, critical understanding of information, setting research problems and choosing ways to solve them;
- skills in working with normative and methodological literature, codes and commentaries to them, laws and by-laws regulating legal relations;
- skills in assessing phenomena and events from the point of view of compliance with the law;
- readiness to make independent legal decisions.

Disciplines preceding the study of the discipline "Jurisprudence": history (history of Russia, world history); foreign language; psychology and pedagogy; philosophy.

The discipline "Jurisprudence, medical law" is a precursor to the study of disciplines, the study of which requires an understanding of the legal regulation of ongoing processes in the field of healthcare.

- draw up procedural documents;

- skills in expressing an independent point of view, analysis and logical thinking, public speaking, moral and ethical argumentation, conducting discussions and round tables;
- skills in working with the reference and legal systems "Consultant Plus" and "Garant".
